# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

2022 - 2023

A little over two years back, in the peak of the COVID-19 outbreak and the lockdown in India, a group of rotarians from Rotary Club of Coimbatore Metropolis decided that it was time that their club sponsored a new rotary club - a club that would be young, dynamic and would be accept a new form of conducting rotary business, an E-Club. This gave birth to Rotary E-Club of Metro Dynamix, a club that meets online and houses members not from one region in one country but from six different countries.



And what a wonderful two and half years it has been for our young club. Until the start of Rotary Year 2022-2023 our club had completed over **25 community service projects** with thousands of beneficiaries. Our projects were conducted across the world and not focused on one region.

On the back of the great work done until June 2021, the Board for 2022-2023 set out take our club to the next level. With that in mind we have so far completed over 10 community service projects by having mobilised almost **Rs 40 lakhs**. These projects would touch the lives of over 700 people across different countries. The club has frozen on its signature project “**Combat Diabetes**” and only under this one banner our club has donated over 50 mini fridges to children suffering from diabetes to be able to store their insulin and other medical requirements. We have also contributed a **fully equipped medical mobile van** to the Idhayangal Charitable Trust to facilitate medical camps and serve the people in rural areas diagnosed with Type 1 & Type 2 diabetes.

But it has not been only work for our rotarians. As Paul Harris had himself once said “**The foundation upon which Rotary is built is friendship; on no less firm foundation could it have stood**”. Keeping this in mind, apart from our meetings online, we have had multiple family evenings when our members have met in person to increase our bonds as friends.

Moving into 2023, we hope to reach greater heights both in terms of our community service projects and other activities to increase the interaction and inter-personal bonds of our members. In terms of our projects, while we will continue with executing projects with similar vigour like we have so far, we are also working towards our first global grant project. In terms of member interaction, we hope to have our first outstation family holiday for our members and their families.

Can't wait for an exciting 2023.

## PROJECT CHILLFIX

We have contributed over 40 mini-refrigerators to families with kids suffering from juvenile diabetes. The refrigerators are used to store life-saving medicines and insulin for their treatment

## PROJECT SWASTI VAHAN

On Dec 11th, we had the inaugural ceremony for the launch of Swasti Vahan by District Collector, Sameeran. Swasti Vahan is a fully equipped medical van that will travel to rural areas all around Tamil Nadu to help diagnose and treat people suffering from Type 1 & Type 2 Diabetes.

Our Club facilitated the donation of INR 35 lakhs from Rasi Seeds to purchase the vehicle. Our gratitude and many thanks to Rasi Seeds Managing Director, Mr. Rajendran, and his team for their generosity.



## PROJECT ABHAYA

Our Club jointly with Banari Amman Spinning Mills Ltd presented a donation of INR 5 lakhs to be used towards procurement of 14 Guadian transmitters that will be used by 100s of children with Juvenile Diabetes. This transmitter will give glucose tracings 24/7 without the need for multiple finger pricks in a day.

## PROJECT BOOK NOOK



We set up 2 Book Nooks in the last six months.

In August 2022, our members Rtn Dr Vimala and Rtn Sheetal Shah, along with Annets Jia and Kyra, distributed toys and games to children admitted in the pediatric ward at PSG Hospitals in Coimbatore

In October 2022, we set up another Book Nook at Panchayat Union Middle School at Govanur, a tribal area near Coimbatore. Ms Akalya got in touch with us for English Books. Our members handed over 60 short story books for the students of classes 6-8. The blue cupboard was also donated.

## PROJECT SHIKSHAA

### SMART INTERACTIVE BOARD

On the eve of Rotary's Literacy month, our member, Vidya, initiated this project. The inauguration was on Sep 23rd. The project aimed at promoting digital learning amongst the students in the rural areas of Coimbatore. Smart Interactive Board equipment was given to the Panchayat Union Middle School, Thudiyalur, Coimbatore. Some students at the school were selected for the NASA ISRO Asteroid Detection Program.



### PROJECT ABILITY

Our Club donated a C-Pen Readers to Magizhvi Foundation on Nov 15th which will enable people with learning disabilities that includes dyslexia, partial blindness and ADHD. Our member, Vidya, sponsored the C-Pen.

Our member Swarnalatha of Swarga Foundation addressed the beneficiaries and motivated them to get self equipped.



## DESIRE SOCIETY PROJECT

To mark the World Aids Day on Dec 1st, on behalf of our club, our member Nikita initiated the effort to provide breakfast to over 200 children living with HIV+/AIDS at Desire Society, across 6 locations - Malad, Vashi, Bangalore, Noida, Hyderabad, and Vizag.



## PROTECTING THE FUTURE

On August 19th, our Club donated bedsheets and towels to the 80 children at Seva Samajam in Chennai. Being an E-Club, we were able to execute this project virtually with members logging in from India, USA and Canada. It was truly a heartwarming experience.



## PROJECT MILKYWAY

On Nov 26th, the 1st phase of this project was executed where our member Mitanshu, along with Yi representative delivered around 300 litres of tetra pack milk which is their requirement for 1 month for all the kids at DESIRE Society Vashi branch. The 2nd phase was executed on Dec 18th. Under this project we are helping the DESIRE Society (a voluntary organisation working for children living with HIV/AIDS who are orphaned / abandoned) with their daily requirement of milk. This project is in collaboration with Round Table 223, Amigos 41ers & Yi Mumbai.

### Rotary initiates project ChillFix to Support Type-1 Diabetes

Rotary has been an integral part of service to society with goodwill and peace. In this regard, the Rotary E-Club of Metro Dynamics has added one more initiative in aiding juvenile diabetes.

According to a report in the Indian Express, India has an estimated 8.6 lakh people with Type 1 diabetes, which is like to increase by 2040. Most underprivileged sectors are vulnerable to acquiring complications like acute coma, blindness, kidney failure or even death if left untreated.

Children suffering from this chronic autoimmune disorder are under regular supervision through medical assistance and insulin supplement for a lifetime. Aiming to help children with Type 1 diabetes, the members of the Rotary E-Club of Metro Dynamics in association with Ishayangal Charitable Trust, launched Project ChillFix under their banner 'Combat Diabetes' that focused on providing mini-refrigerators.

The Ishayangal Charitable Trust, run by Dr. Krishnam Swaminathan is constantly involved in providing free

medical assistance and insulin supply to children with Type 1 diabetes. Restoring the supplied insulin is challenging especially for kids from the poor and underprivileged sectors, as it requires financial assistance to obtain a refrigerator. A note of caution is that the insulin loses its potency if not stored under an appropriate temperature.

As a note to support this challenging fact, the two organizations came forward to donate mini refrigerators to children with juvenile diabetes. The project was launched in September, following its inaugural ceremony. As many as



40 mini refrigerators have been donated to 40 children to date. Each of the donated refrigerators is worth Rs.8,000.

Commenting on ChillFix, Rtn. Roshna Ramesh, Project Director, said, "If this little amount of 8,000 could save a family, then we aim to support and save the lives of as many children as possible. We do not wish to fix a particular target number but extend our help to many children."

The Rotary E-Club project headed by Rtn. Roshna Ramesh, along with her team members Rtn. Nikhil Shah and Rtn. Vidya Natunjan has served a crucial role in making this possible.

### Embracing digital learning and improving the quality of life

Community services are the need for the hour, with numerous instances happening across countries for the improvement of integrity and goodwill. In this reference, Rotary International has become an integral part.

Observations of research on the other untouched areas of academic opportunities in society revealed that learning disabilities ranging from dyslexia and ADHD to partial blindness affect about 25% of the young population around the globe.



The Rotary E-Club of Metro Dynamics has announced the launch of the pilot project, "Project Ability", in Coimbatore that aims to turn learning disability into ability. It is a few-of-its-kind project in Coimbatore. The club comprising 41 young and vibrant members spread across countries, joins hands to carry out service projects, specifically in Coimbatore and includes other parts of India.

enhance digital learning capabilities and to provide equal opportunity to all children. Observations of research on the other untouched areas of academic opportunities in society revealed that learning disabilities ranging from dyslexia and ADHD to partial blindness affect about 25% of the young population around the globe.

Earlier this week, a collaborative pilot project, "C-Pen Distribution" under Project Ability, was initiated. Rtn. Vidya with her team members Rtn. Roshna Ramesh and Rtn. Ishita Bhavsani and other club members have contributed a C-Pen device worth Rs. 40,000.

As of today, the Rotary e-club members have contributed one C-Pen device to Magdori Foundation. Taking this further, the team aims to increase the numbers by four and many more in the future. The NGO 'Mde' with the Coimbatore Corporation and the Central Library enables them to implement this project at the reading camps conducted at the Magdori main schools in Coimbatore and the Central Library. Each reading camp includes about 20 to 40 students assisted by volunteers who will administer device usage among the students and monitor their improvement.

This ineligibility and the need for awareness brought together the hands of the rotary club and the Magdori Foundation, providing little insights into the Magdori Foundation, the included in that it is a Coimbatore-based NGO working with the motto of 'inclusive development' towards sustainable development, disability being the core area of work. Being proceeded with former corporate employees, they provide skill training, education and vocational training for the welfare of people with disabilities, including employment orientation and mentoring to become self-sufficient.

This C-Pen is an assistive reading tool commonly used in America and the United Kingdom, readily available for students with reading and writing disabilities. It enables the students to work independently without much external assistance. This scanner pen scans the textbook and convert it into audio. The files for the same are made accessible to the user.



She added, "Educational representatives are embracing digital learning and are open to improving the quality of life and education for people with disabilities. Thanks to the pandemic fostering students in digital usage, which in turn makes this device much more manageable to adapt among the students."
